The eHealth Governance Initiative, as a unique network,

- ✂ links up governments, health professionals, patients and citizens,
- ✂ establishes trust and acceptability for all stakeholders of eHealth,
- ✂ supports the realisation of patients rights in cross-border healthcare,
- ✂ helps to advance the European eHealth Interoperability Roadmap and
- ✂ provides input to the EU Article 14 eHealth Network.



The eHGI aims to achieve an eHealth governance structure, i.e. strategies, priorities, recommendations and guidelines on how to develop eHealth in Europe in a coordinated manner. eHGI is a joint effort, involving stakeholders, especially patients and health professionals as well as industrials, in the hope of ensuring continuity of the healthcare provided either at home or crossing borders.

eHGI comprises eHealth stakeholders all over Europe who advise and recommend actions to decision makers. eHGI convenes 27 Government Authorities and 13 NGOs from all around Europe.

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
